Conditions.

All ewes exceeding 1 1/2 years in all sections, shall have a lamb at foot, be visibly in lamb or visibly to have reared a lamb

All sheep must be registered in a recognised Flock Book.

All rams in the show must be from accredited ovine brucellosis-free flocks or have been tested prior to Show with negative results.

Membership of the Show Society shall be \$25 per annum-GST inc. This entitles entry to the Showground for 2 adults, 2 children & a car.

Sheep to be penned by 8.30am

Sheep are not to be removed from the ground before the conclusion of all judging, including junior judging.

National Sheep Health Statement must be completed and returned with entries.

All entries must be from flocks in the Sheep Market Assurance Program (SheepMAP) or be approved vaccinates for Ovine Johnes Disease

Junior Judging Competition for British Breeds Sheep

Judging will be split into 2 classes:

- Class 1. Competitors must be under 15 years on 1st May, 2018
- Class 2. To be over 15 years & under 25 years on 1st May 2018

Winner of class 2 is eligible to compete for the State Title. Winner of the State Final to compete at the National Finals.

Judging will take place after the Interbreed classes are completed - exact time to be advised on the day.

All competitors over the age of 15 are required to pay a \$5 entry fee, as per Tasmanian Agricultural Shows instructions.

NLIS EAR TAGS

NLIS ear tags must be in all sheep including lambs as per current Department of Primary Industry Regulations.
