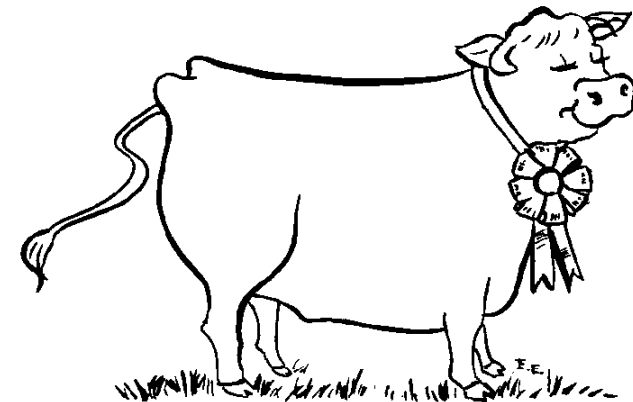

**ALL STOCK MUST BE ON SHOW GROUND BY 8.00 a.m.
JUDGING TO COMMENCE AT 9.00 a.m. SHARP**

Exhibits in Cattle Section will be restricted as follows:

- All Cattle to be registered with their respective Herd Society, Prime Stock accepted.
- Cattle not to be loaded or removed from the ground before the completion of judging. on day of show.
- All trucks to be parked in allocated space behind chopping. Follow the signs

All exhibits must appear in the ring for Judging beginning at 9 am

- Exhibitors wishing to compete for Trophies in Groups and in Special Classes must state their wishes clearly and supply all the necessary information on the Entry Form.
- Every beast calved before March 1st in any year shall be deemed to be one year old on that date. Date of birth must be stated on Entry Form.
- A yearling is eligible for Championship Prizes.
- All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor on the day of exhibition.
- All bulls other than yearlings must have rings and must be provided with leading Tackle and all Cattle other than Prime must be tied up with strong halters and Neck Straps overnight.
- A de-horned animal competing in the Dairy Cattle Classes shall not be penalised.
- A milking machine provided by Agritech Pty. Ltd. Devonport, will be available for use by exhibitors.

NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYTSEM

All animals must have NLIS ear tags before entering the showgrounds.

UNTAGGED ANIMALS WILL BE UNABLE TO COMPETE.

**All necessary information MUST be completed on the entry form.
Animals will be scanned before judging begins.**

ELECTRICITY

All electrical cords must be elevated at least 3 metres above the ground. Any person intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showground is requested to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. Double adaptors and piggy back plugs **must not** be used on power supply outlets at any time. DAPS or its representatives shall have the right to disconnect any electrical apparatus that may be deemed unsafe or may be overloading service lines. Please check all your equipment before you come to the grounds to avoid difficulties.
